The trials are open to both girls and boys in the age groups below, who either live, or receive full time education within the London Borough of Bromley.

Age groups are based on UKA age group categories – this is the age you were on the 31st August 2011.

Each trial will start and finish on the running track at Norman Park: the course will consist of a double circuit of the perimeter pathways of the park*. Competitors **MUST** arrive in good time to collect their running numbers. There will be no acknowledgement of entries, but please note that **entries will not be accepted without an authorised signature of a parent / guardian, or if appropriate details are incomplete.**

If you are unable to attend the trials, you **MUST** supply details of your recent performances in the Kent or Surrey county and schools cross country championships and recent performances in the Kent and Surrey cross country league for consideration. A minimum of 5 places will be available in each age group at the trials.

Successful participants that secure a space on the team will represent Bromley in the Virgin Mini London Marathon on **Sunday 22nd April 2012. Team members** will eligible for a ticket to the Olympics.

The London Marathon is delighted to be able to offer participants in the 2012 Virgin Mini London Marathon a ticket for **one of the athletic sessions in the Olympics next August**. Tickets have been purchased by the London Marathon through UK Athletics ticket allocation who have made them available in order to support grass roots athletics. More information will be sent to participants before the event. This opportunity is only open to participants that are part of the Bromley team and will receive more detail in due course.
