

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG ATHLETES

Blackheath & Bromley Harriers AC operates with the following Principles of Participation in mind. All young people attending the B & BHAC Youth Club should be aware of the following principles and agree to abide by them at all times.

	Principles of Participation	Code of Conduct
•	Fair Play	Treat others with the same respect and fairness that you would like them to show you.
•	Equity	Respect differences in gender, ability, culture, race, ethnicity and religious beliefs between yourself and others.
•	Responsibility	Look out for yourself and the welfare of others. Do not engage in any irresponsible or illegal behaviour. Challenge behaviour by teammates that falls below the expected standards of Blackheath & Bromley Harriers AC. Speak out if you are concerned about anything or if you feel uncomfortable about your own needs & those of others.
•	Behaviour	Alcohol, cigarettes or illegal and performance enhancing drugs are not allowed. Respect should be shown to others at all times and no foul or offensive language should be used. Good behaviour is expected at all times. Any damage caused, other than by accident, by club members will have to be paid for by them.
•	Personal Items	Valuable items should not be brought to the Youth Club and no responsibility can be taken by the Club for loss or damage of any personal articles.
	The Youth Club will operate a Yellow/Red Card system.	
	Yellow Card will be shown as a warning for poor/unacceptable behaviour. Red Card will be given if there is severe unacceptable behaviour. If the Red card is shown your parent/guardian will be called to collect you from the Youth Club immediately.
