Last weekend saw 20 of the club's athletes compete at the British Championships in Birmingham, with 8 coming home with medals!

- 3. Faith Akinbileje secured British 100m bronze running 11.34 just one hundredth ahead of 4th
- 4. Jack Kavanaugh (2nd claim) was second in the men's 5k behind Josh Kerr
- 5. Bekah Walton won the women's javelin
- 6. Our world para-athletics javelin champion Hollie Arnold also won javelin
- 7. Nana Gyedu was 3rd in the women's shot put
- 8. Daniela Goriola was 2nd in the men's 110mH
