It was a tremendously successful competition, highlighted by two team medals and many great performances, but it would not have been possible without your help.

The trial will take place on Wednesday, 18th March at 5 pm in Norman Park, will consist of a 2.6km run around the park path, and will finish on the track, via the gate closest to the play park.

The trials are open to pupils in years 5+6 (under 12), years 7+8 (under 14), years 9+10 (under 16) and years 11+12 (under 18). We can take a team of 4 boys and 4 girls in

the U12 category, and teams of 6 in all other age groups. Athletes selected for the English Schools XC Champs do not need to trial, but they still need to register via the link. Those unable to trial can request a wildcard consideration, but they must also register via the link.

The application closing date is 5 pm on Monday, 16th March.

The National Cross Country Championships at Sedgefield proved to be a superb day for the club, with outstanding individual performances, impressive depth across all age groups, and significant team success. From our youngest athletes to our seniors, the club was represented with determination, quality and pride.

In the Under 13 girls' race, **Jasmine Stephens (31st)** led the team home with an excellent top 40 finish. She was well supported by **Lucy Junginger (57th)**, **Sofia James (61st)**, **Zara Lett (73rd)**, and Elsa Matthews (87th), all securing top-100 finishes in a highly competitive field. Strong and determined runs also came from **Holly Tallack**, **Ella Nickson**, **Mollie Sedgwick**, **Arienne Paranjpe**, and **Alice Bunn**, each contributing to a very solid team performance at the national level.

The Under 13 boys delivered one of the standout achievements of the day, securing National Team Silver. **Zachary Evans (6th)** produced a superb top 10 finish, demonstrating real class at the front of the race. He was closely followed by **Emery Aldridge (21st)** with another excellent performance. Crucial scoring positions were provided by **Luc Jones (69th)** and **Anthony Streich (73rd)**, both finishing inside the top 100 to seal the team medal. Strong support also came from **Fletcher Kelly, Haydn Kenny, and Alexander Coe**, completing a fantastic collective effort.

In the Under 15 girls' race, the team showed great resilience and competitive spirit. **Evie De Bruyn (33rd)** led the group with a strong run, followed by **Harriet Hughes (41st)** and **Sofia Mossi (92nd)**, all finishing inside the top 100. Excellent efforts also came from **Alba Homans-Yau, Eva John, Elisabeth McGillivray, Lily Day, Amelie Ramdeen, Aoife Stanley, and Isabella Jenkins**, who competed admirably in a demanding race.

The Under 17 women were led home by **Naimah Mossi (60th)**, with **Aoife McDonagh (64th)** and **Niamh Stanley (79th)** also securing top 100 finishes. **Charlotte Stevens** and **Lily Bridgeman** added further strong performances in a highly competitive field.

The Under 17 men were crowned National Team Champions in a truly exceptional display of strength and depth. At the front of the race, **Joseph Scanes (3rd)** and **Joseph Hill (4th)** delivered outstanding podium-level performances, setting the foundation for team gold. They were superbly backed by **Oliver Ward (35th), Benjamin O'Grady (38th), Aniket Iyenger (41st)** and **Kian Farrell (73rd)**, all finishing inside the top 100 to emphatically secure the national title. Further depth was provided by **Nathan Clark** and **Madalitso Valema-Mwanza**, underlining the strength of this age group.

In the Under 20 women's race, **Carys Firth (45th)** and **Kyla Dervish (58th)** both ran confidently to secure top 100 finishes at the national level, showing composure and competitiveness throughout.

The Under 20 men were led by **Jed Starvis (19th)**, who produced an excellent top 20 national finish in a high-quality field. **Mark Constable (94th)** also secured a top 100 placing, while **Harry Fage** gave his all to come 2nd in the Flycarb Super Sprint!

The senior women delivered a superb collective performance to finish fourth overall, narrowly missing a national podium spot. **Niamh Bridson-Hubbard (9th)** led the way with an outstanding top 10 finish, closely followed by **Andrea Clement (12th)** in another exceptional run. Strong scoring performances from **Ailbhe Barnes (38th)** and **Millie Smith (42nd)**, both inside the top 50, were vital to the team's success, with **Gracie Horton** backing up well.

In the senior men's race, the team showed determination and resilience across a challenging course. **Daniel Kennedy** led the club home, followed by committed performances from **William Reedman-White, David Adams, and Micah Evans**. Strong efforts also came from **Ian**

Scott, Barry Horgan, Steven Pairman, and Chris Martin, each battling hard in a large and competitive field.
